To Create Connectivity

Your land could play a critical role in supporting monarch butterflies along their annual migration across the San Joaquin Valley. Join us to build habitat and receive benefits in soil fertility and microbial diversity, better water retention, decreased soil loss, more cost-effective pest control, and enhanced stewardship of your land.

## Receive Free Native Plants

The Xerces Society is working in collaboration with local Resource Conservation Districts to identify farms, ranches, or organizations in the San Joaquin Valley who want to create monarch/pollinator habitat that can be protected from pesticides.

Projects can be selected to receive free native plants for hedgerows or wildflower meadows, as well as technical assistance in planning for implementation and maintenance of these habitat projects.
